

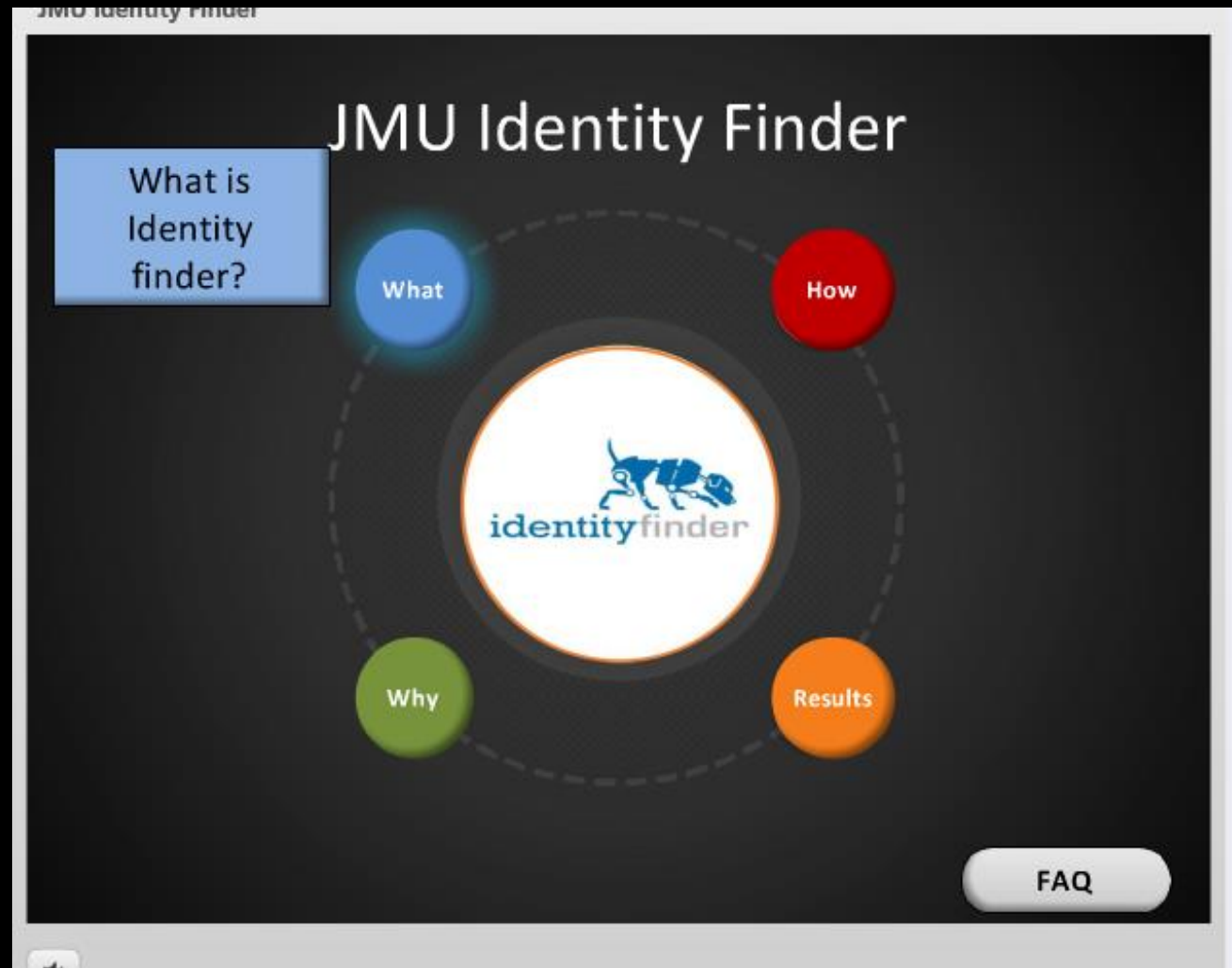
Main Menu

This is the main Menu. When you hover over each button it will display a pop-up providing you with more information.




What is identity finder?

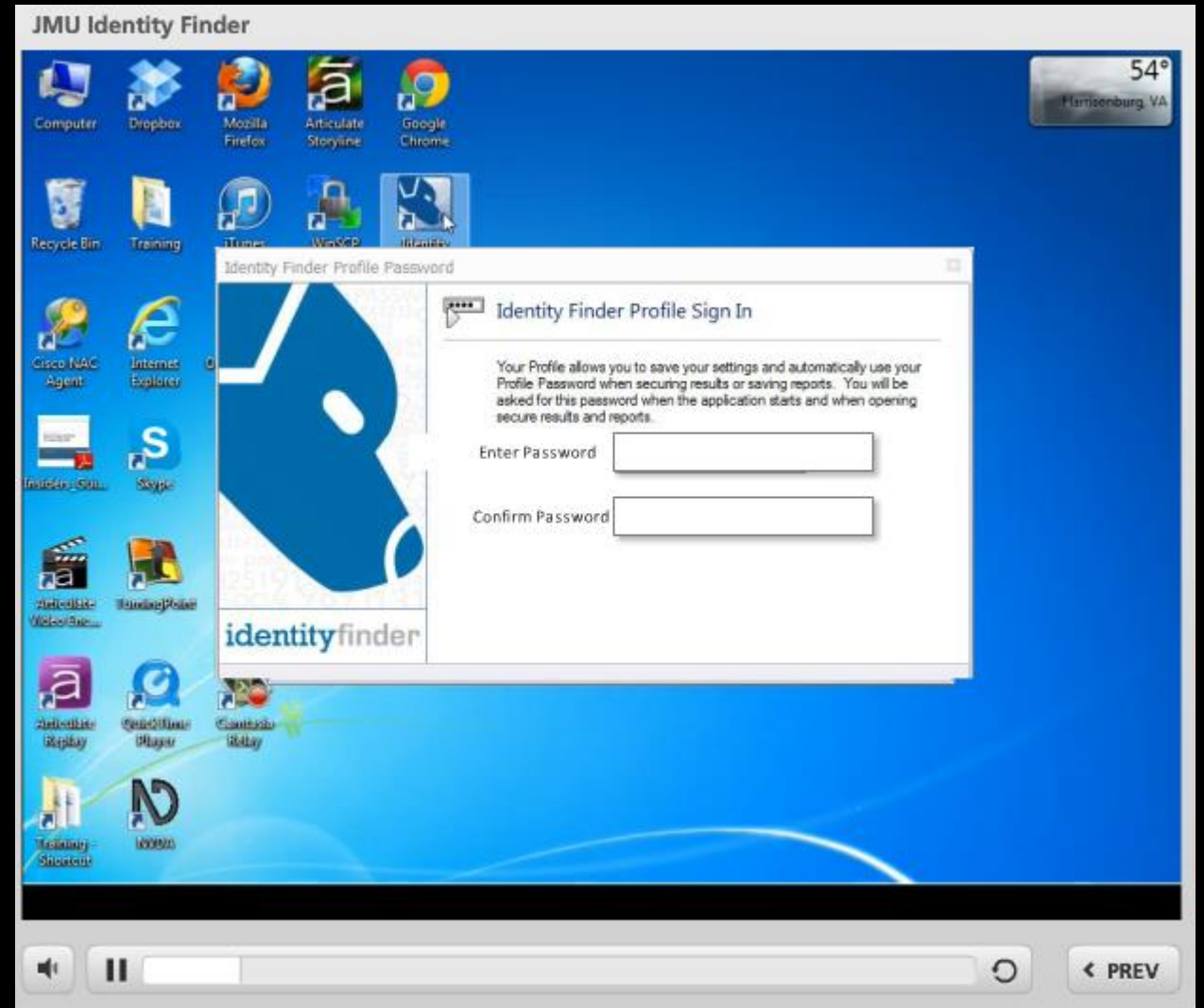

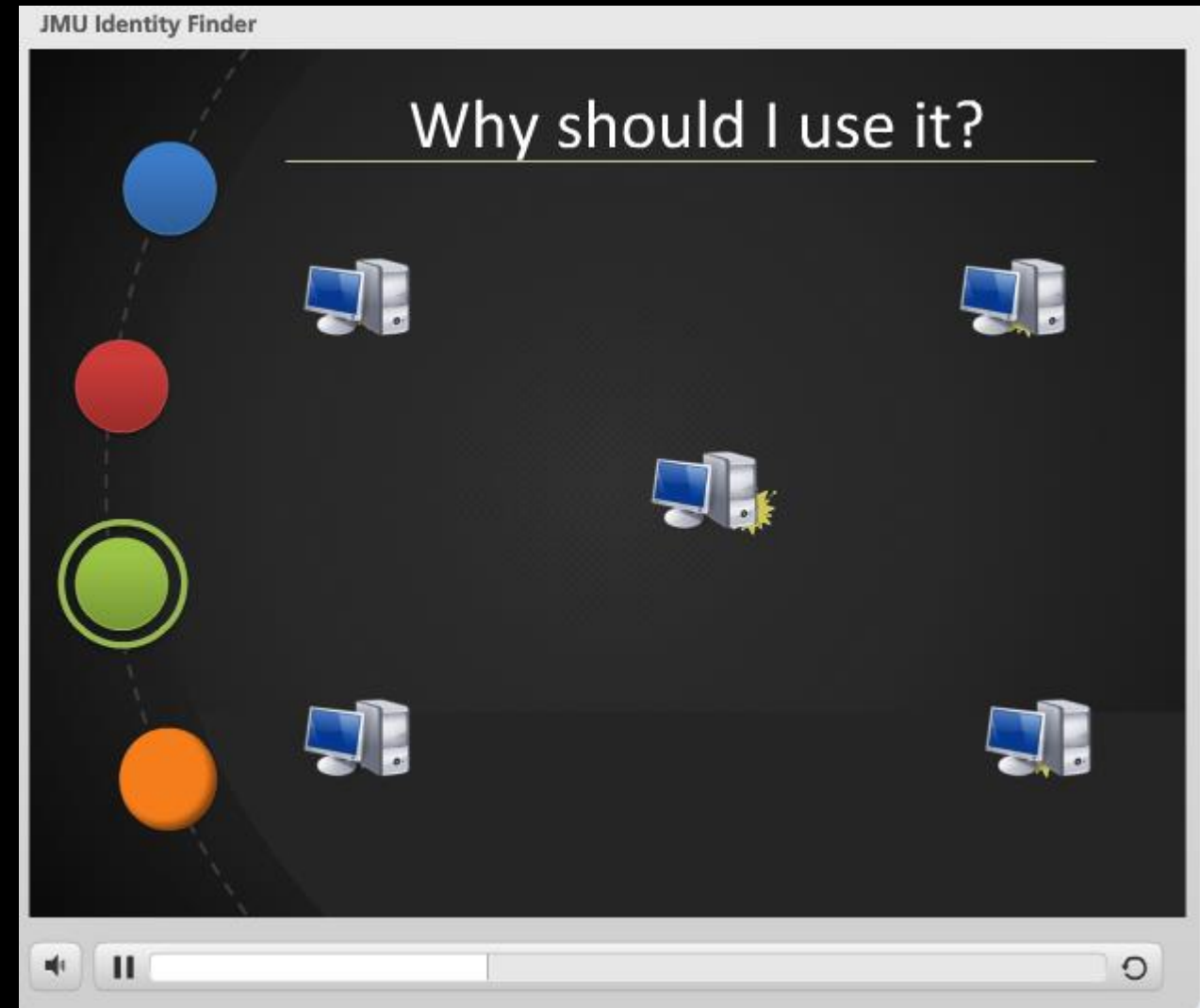
Why should I use it?



Meaning of the Results

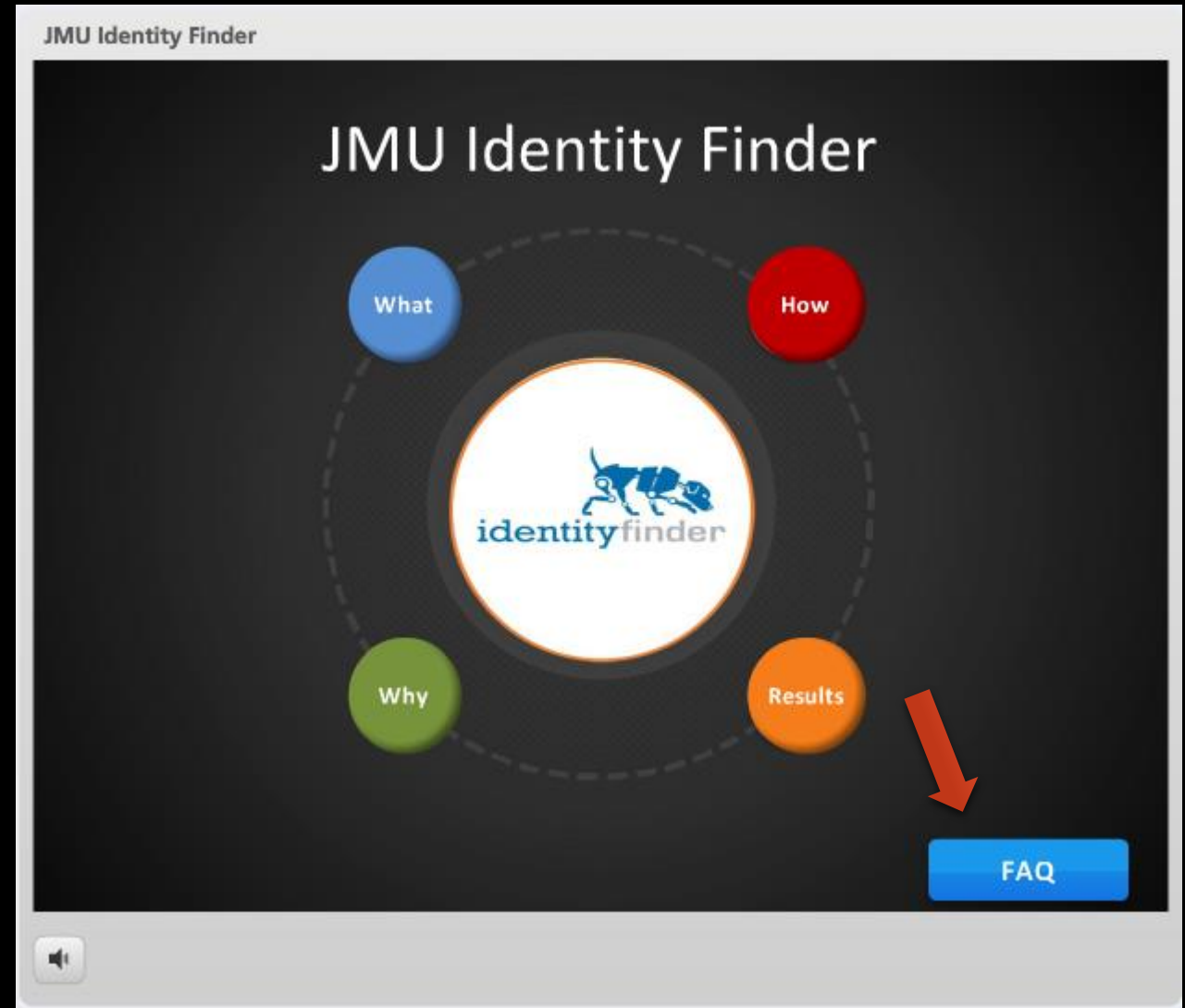
- **Shred**: this will securely delete the file.
- **Scrub**: delete the the flagged information from within the document but keep the document itself.
- **Secure**: this is not used at JMU.
- **Quarantine**: this will move the file to a designated folder.
- **Recycle**: this is not used at JMU.
- **Ignore**: this is **ONLY** used for a false positive.

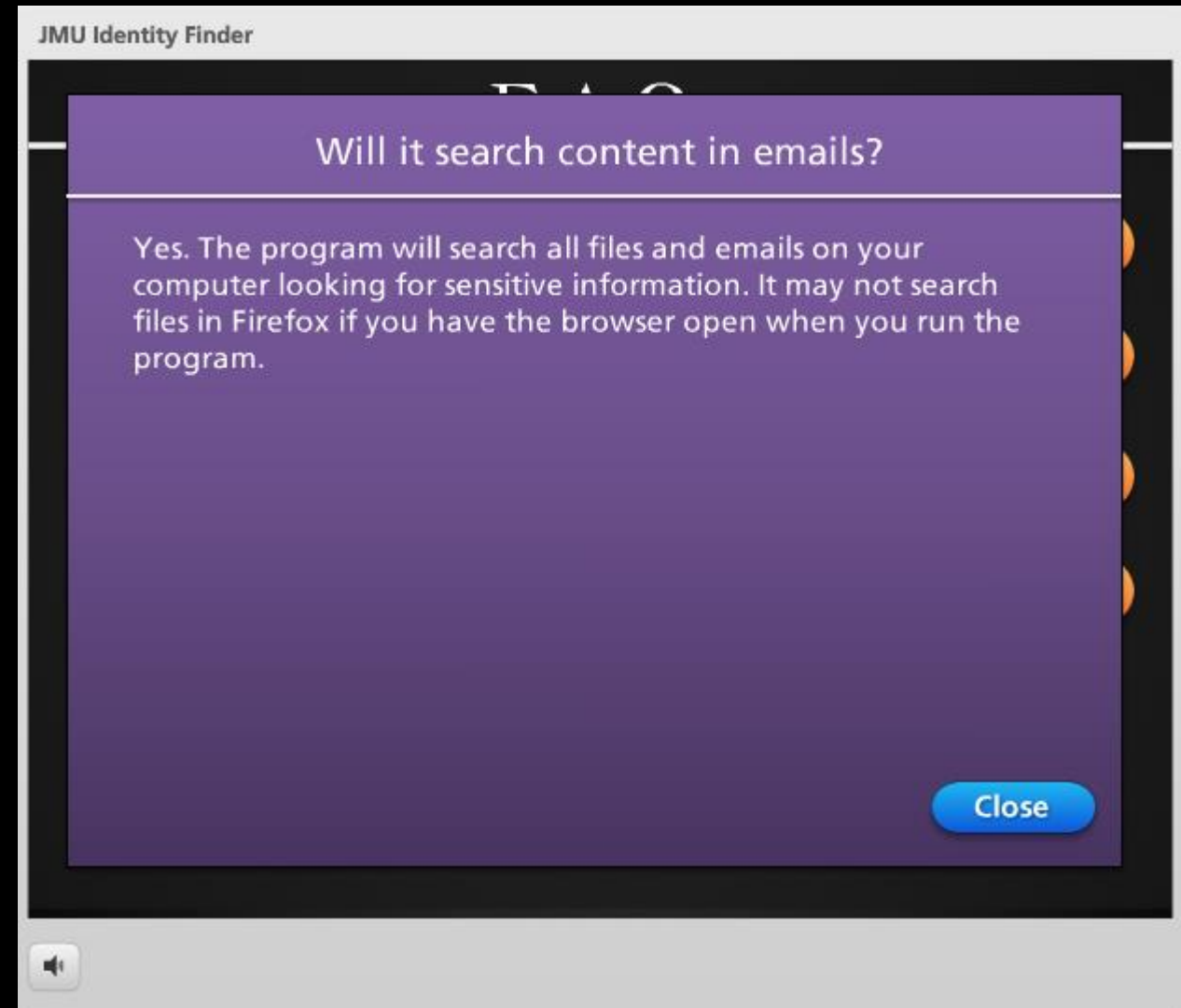
